# Dear Parents/Caregivers

The Madeley Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2025. The schedule is broken into four sections and will allow you to calculate all costs that may be incurred throughout the school year.

### CONTRIBUTIONS

The total amount of contributions parents/caregivers are being asked to pay has been contained within the \$60.00 maximum set in the School Education Regulations 2000.

Your voluntary contribution will be used towards additional resources in the following areas: Literacy, Numeracy, Humanities, STEM, Science and Physical/ Health Education.

# Student Resources \$60 (Years K – 6)

These costs are in line with our Cluster. If there is financial hardship, please contact the Manager of Corporate Services as soon as possible so that a mutually acceptable payment plan can be made for you.

### **CHARGES - FOR EXTRA COST OPTIONAL COMPONENTS**

A breakdown of estimated charges for your child's participation in excursions, incursions, activities for 2025 has been included in the table opposite page. The amounts shown represent the <u>maximum charged</u> for scheduled activities in 2025 **You will be asked to make payment for each activity as it approaches.** 

The charges schedule includes costs associated with:

- Specific learning activities and available to **all** students, but conditional on a payment being made. eg. incursions, excursions, classroom cooking, etc.
- Specific learning activities available to selected students, but conditional on a payment being made. eg, Music program.
- Other activities available to all students, but conditional on a payment being made. eg. Camps, Academic Competitions etc.

**NB:** The Apple 1-1 laptop program is for year 5 & 6 students in 2025 and is a parent funded <u>voluntary</u> program.

### \*Apple 1-1 Program

The Ashdale Cluster of schools is committed to providing all Year 5 & 6 students with up to date technology knowledge. This **voluntary program** involves families leasing or purchasing an Apple MacBook for their child to use for educational purposes anywhere and anytime for three years. A variety of approved devices are available which currently range in price from MacBook Air \$1,799/256GB; \$2,099/512GB (M1 – 4 week wait). The purchase of a hard drive (MacBook only) and cover/case for the device is recommended although not essential. The students use their device both at home and at school to ensure they have access to information and creative tools at time of need. Parent feedback along with dedicated and enthusiastic staff, guide the program each year to constantly review and improve the opportunities for our students. Information about the approved devices/bundles and an online order form will be made available via a link that is posted on Seesaw in Term 4 or alternatively parents may purchase elsewhere.

### ITEMS FOR PERSONAL USE

The charges for personal use items will vary from student to student and includes:

- Items for all students that are used in daily lessons e.g. Stationery items, calculator etc
- Items that are recommended but not essential for all students e.g. tissues, art shirt etc.
- Items required by selected students and not directly part of the educational program e.g. class photographs, etc

A recommended list of materials your child will require this year has been provided. All materials can be purchased through West School Supplies orders however you are not obliged to use this local supplier.

Your child will need to have the listed materials each school day so it may be necessary to replace some items, such as pens or pencils, throughout the year.

# **School Fundraising for Special Causes**
