For the past few weeks, our theme has been Christmas in June; we have been making decorations, decorating the Christmas tree and making cards. We would like to invite everyone to our room to view your children's creations

An exciting activity that all the children wanted to get involved in was our puff paint experiment. The kids all enjoyed experimenting with a new type of painting. This helped the children in supporting their fine motor skills, learning about new textures, and how to make this special paint

### INGREDIENTS:

- 1 Cup of self-rising flour
- 2 teaspoons of salt
- 1 teaspoon of baking powder
- 1 cup of water
- 2-3 drop of food colouring

Method: Combine the self-raising flower, salt, and baking powder in a bowl, add water gradually, and then stir in food colouring. Pour into paint/sauce bottles or plastic glad lock bags. If in glad lock bags cut a hole in the corner. Microwave for 30 seconds and 1 minute if paint is thick.

The last few days the children have been really interested in the soccer world cup, they have been perusing news and picture articles, making flags for the teams they are supporting, and organizing soccer tournaments. We will be having our own world cup day during our holiday programme, which begins on the 7<sup>th</sup> July. There will be lots of fun activities, incursions and excursions to look forward too.
