Other suggestions to reduce congestions include:

1. Walk instead of driving
2. Park in a side street and walk
3. Come a few minutes later

Remember that everyone wants to pick their child up in a safe and timely manner. Being in a hurry is not an excuse for poor behaviour so please be patient, kind and considerate. By working together we can improve pick-up times for everyone.
