



Dear Parent/Caregiver

During term three and four, Ashdale Secondary College will be hosting a Year 6 Transition Program for all students who are within the Cluster or enrolled to attend the College in Year 7 2017. The 4 day Program will start with two consecutive Wednesdays in Term 3 and will have a further 2 days in Term 4. The four days have been allocated to specific activities designed to support students and provide them with opportunities for 2017.

- Term 3, Wednesday 17 & Wednesday 24 August
- Term 4, Tuesday 29 November and Wednesday 30 November

During the transition days all students will participate in the four core subjects and have an opportunity to taste Dance, Food, Jewelry, Sport and other elective subjects. In Term 4 the Physical Education staff will be hosting trials for the Ashdale SC Netball and Soccer Academies. Students wishing to try out should ensure they are in appropriate clothing on those days.

The Year 6 Transition program has been designed to familiarise students with a secondary school timetable, experience the different specialist areas available at Ashdale SC, and have the opportunity to meet students who will be a part of their cohort in 2017. The students will be operating on a timetable that is reflective of the Year 7 model, however will continue to study the Year 6 curriculum.

Students attending the Term 4 Year 6 Transition Program on Tuesday 29 November are to meet in the College Foyer at 8.45am and will attend an assembly in the Galileo Theatre where information on the two day program will be provided to them. All students should bring their subject books, as well as pencil case and notepaper.
