### **Course Description**

#### **Lower School**

At all schools the four hour per week course covers:

- Development of batting, bowling, fielding and mental skills.
- History of cricket.
- Fitness training.
- Match strategies.
- Training camps.
- Umpiring.
- Captaincy
- Modified games/indoor cricket.
- Interschool matches.
- Interstate and international tours.

#### **Senior School**

All schools offer upper school university and Training WA (formerly TAFE) bound courses to meet student needs. This includes the Physical Education Studies Course of Study and Certificate II in Sport.
