

- ✓ **SOMETHING TO WEAR:** t-shirt, polo shirt, shorts, skirt, cap, beanie, sandals, etc. ✓ **SOMETHING TO LOVE**: teddy bear, doll,
- soft toy, etc. ✓ **SOMETHING SPECIAL:** carry bag, sunglasses, bangles, stickers, necklaces, craft kits, wind-
- up torch, a personal note, a photo of yourself, etc. ✓ **SOMETHING FOR SCHOOL:** exercise book, pencil case, pens, pencils, colouring pencils,
- sharpener, eraser, chalk, etc. SOMETHING TO PLAY WITH: tennis ball. cars, skipping rope, marbles, musical instrument, yo-yo, slinky, finger puppets, etc.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

project costs

- ¥ ITEMS THAT LEAK OR MELT: (these can spoil boxes) including toothpaste, shampoo. bubbles, crayons and plasticine/play dough
- **X** FOOD OR LOLLIES OF ANY KIND: (due to customs regulations) including medicines and vitamins
- **★ USED OR DAMAGED ITEMS:** (due to customs regulations) including worn clothing and old
- **✗ BREAKABLE ITEMS:** including glass, porcelain
- X ITEMS THAT CAN SCARE OR HARM A CHILD: including halloween, war or pirate-related items such as toy guns, knives, military figures or skull and crossbones
- ★ GAMBLING-RELATED ITEMS: including play money. playing cards and dominoes
- ★ RELIGIOUS LITERATURE: including tracts and Bibles (every child is given an Operation Christmas Child evangelistic book at an outreach event)
