<u>Drop off time-</u> Students are to be dropped off at Ashdale College at <u>8:30am</u> in the Performing Arts building near Administration.

Rehearsal time: 9:00am - 10:00am

Performance time: 11.30am - approximately 12:30/1.00pm

<u>What to bring-</u> The School Choir members will need to arrive in their choir shirts which will be provided to them before the day. The Year 6 ukulele and percussion students will need to come in their normal school uniform. All students will need their school bags and food for the day.

Students will be transported back to school by the Ashdale Secondary College bus to arrive at school during lunch time.

School choir students will need to take their choir shirt home at the end of the day to be washed and returned to the school as soon as possible.
