

## Muddy Gully Incursion Year Ones from LLA 4, LLA 5, MLA 1 & MLA 3

Dear Parents and Guardians

We have organised an interactive and educational incursion for the <u>Year One</u> students to enjoy later this term. The Year Two students participated in this incursion last year, so they <u>are not</u> involved in 2019. Please read the information below provided by Educated by Nature, who will be facilitating this incursion:

Natural clay offers tactile experiences that engage the senses, inspire creativity and support fine and gross motor skills. This incursion gives children an opportunity to take sensory risks in a supportive environment. Sloppy, firm, gooey and muddy clay is available for small scale or full body exploration of clay in various forms. Natural ochres are provided for face painting with an indigenous connection. Water play is also an important part of this incursion - a chance to tip, pour, collect and splash.

## Every child will need:

- **To wear to school:** <u>OLD</u> clothes, both top and bottom and an old/alternative hat (only wear items you do not mind getting dirty and/or stained). No sleeveless tops or bathers please.
- To change into afterwards: School uniform top and bottoms and clean underwear
- Full water bottle
- An old towel for drying off after being hosed off
- A large spare plastic bag for the muddy clothes to go in after

**NB:** All students will need to come to school already dressed in their OLD CLOTHES. Please ensure all clothes your child wears allow them to still toilet independently. Students can wear their usual footwear to school, as they will take them off before the incursion. All items must be name labelled. Sunscreen must be applied at home to any skin which will be exposed to the sun before coming to school.
