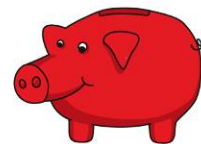

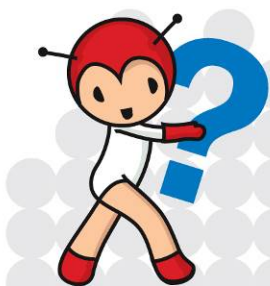


Healthy Snacks
