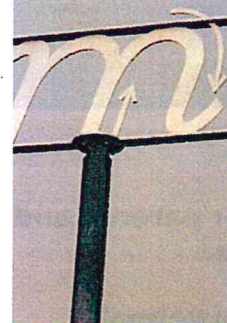
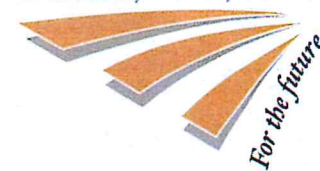

Annual events such as Easter on the Green and School Discos are coordinated by the P&C

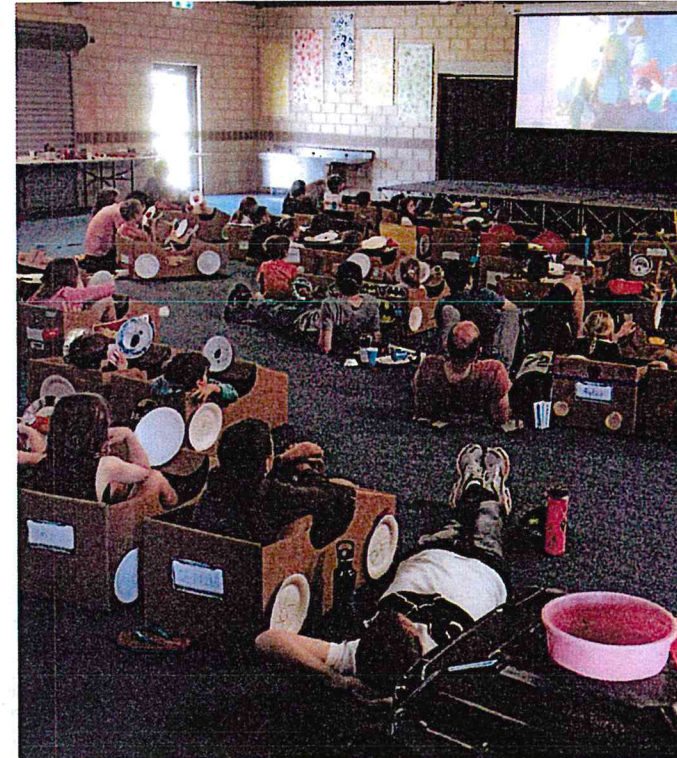
Canteen
