

APPLICATION SPECIALIST VOLLEYBALL PROGRAM

Greenwood College runs a widely recognised and highly successful Specialist Volleyball Program. The program provides students the opportunity to develop and enhance a high level of leadership, teamwork, volleyball performance, game sense and understanding of the sport. The program offers integrated indoor and beach volleyball for all students selected.

The Greenwood College Specialist Volleyball Program has a long history of developing talented state representatives who have proudly represented the College and Western Australia. Inter school tournaments and annual tours for National Championship competitions are all part of the Specialist Volleyball experience. All students enrolled in volleyball participate in competitive specialised volleyball classes facilitated by experienced and specialist coaching staff.

- Successful applicants will be required to participate fully in the program including out of school hours activities such as training, camps and competitions.
- There is a requirement that students who enter the Volleyball Specialist Program will commit to the program until the end of Year 10. Out of area enrolments will need to enrol in their local intake school should they withdraw from the program.
- As a condition of continued enrolment at Greenwood College, the school requires students to achieve to a set standard in their specialisation and in other studies for the four years they are in the program.

Applicants should provide evidence in their application of the following criteria:

Required

- Demonstrated high standards of personal behaviour and academic achievement;
- Experience being a member of sporting teams, showing a commitment to training and an ability to excel in teamwork situations;
- Dedication to extra-curricular trainings and carnivals; and
- Highly capable and enthusiastic performer in sporting activities.

Selection process:

- 1. Application to be lodged with the initial "Application for Enrolment" for new Greenwood College students or 'Subject Selection Sheet" for existing Greenwood students.
- 2. New Greenwood students will be invited to attend a Volleyball Assessment at Greenwood College, if required.
- 3. Applicants will be notified as soon as the process is completed.
- 4. Successful applicants will be required to complete the Specialist Program Code of Conduct and will commence in the Program as advised.
